<p>1. Diseases (Old World to New World)</p> <p>Diseases from Europe (small pox) killed off most of America's native population</p>	<p>2. Diseases (New World to Old World)</p> <p>Syphilis travelled back to Europe. → European nations blamed each other.</p>	<p>3. Animals (Old World to New World)</p> <p>-Horses &amp; large, domesticated animals changed transport &amp; farming in the Americas.</p>
<p>4. Crops (Old World to New World)</p> <p>Old world brought apples, bananas, beets, and coffee. Result = land could grow more food</p>	<p>5. Crops (New World to Old World)</p> <p>could grow in areas that were not good for farming european crops. Could feed more people. potato the most important crop</p>	<p>6. Beginning of slavery in the New World</p> <p>Most slaves brought over to grow sugarcane. More slaves brought from Africa to Brazil than to North America.</p>
